Title:

Literacy Tutor

Purpose:

To help an adult learn to read and write. Widen horizons and empower an adult student.

Commitment:

A commitment of one year is required in providing a 2 hour tutoring session per week.

Training:

Core training is provided at a 2 day tutor-training workshop. This will provide volunteers with the training they will need. Office support is provided thereafter.



One-to-one Tutoring

We'll match you with an adult student who has difficulty with reading, writing and spelling. You will meet once per week for two hours of tutor instruction, at a place and time that is convenient for both tutor and student. Students will not only receive assistance with literacy skills, but will receive assistance with their individual literacy related goals. This volunteer role provides you with scheduling flexibility, convenience and staff support.
