

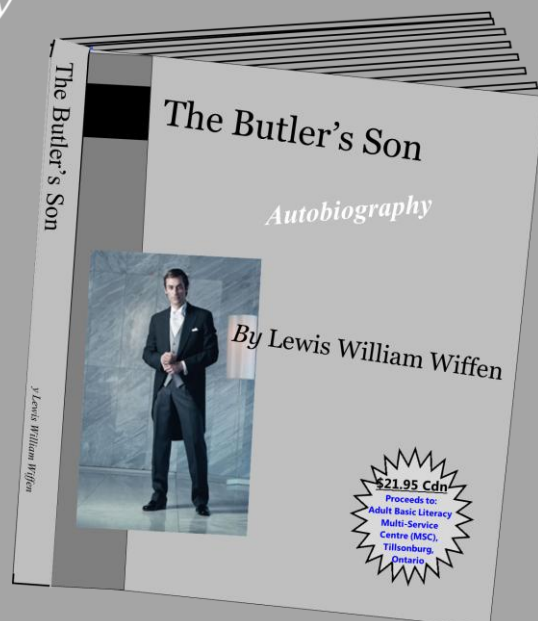
# The Butler's Son
