VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

I. Adult Literacy & Essential Skills:

- Volunteer Tutor

Volunteers provide one-to-one tutoring for adult students who need to improve reading, writing and spelling skills. Benefits of this role are revealed in improved literacy skills of the student, improved ability of students to handle daily literacy tasks (e.g., handling mail, reading community signs, completing work related materials, etc.), and increased independence, confidence and self-esteem. Volunteers receive the training necessary for the tutoring role. Call x 266.

II. Home Support Services:

- Meals On Wheels Drivers & Helpers

Volunteers pick-up hot noontime meals from a local supplier and deliver them to seniors within the Tillsonburg area (including Courtland and Norwich, as required). This service also provides clients with a smiling face and a quick safety & security check. Call x 357.

- Transportation Drivers

Volunteers drive clients who are unable to drive themselves to various appointments in or out of town while providing a friendly visit on the way. Volunteers are offered compensation for mileage. Call x 357.

III. Fundraising/Special Activities:

- Fundraising Events/Special Initiatives Committee Member

MSC has events every year that support the Adult Basic Literacy Program (and other special initiatives). Committee members assist in the organizing of these activities with staff support. Committee members generally meet monthly for a 6 month period, with extra time required for team tasks associated with specific events. Call x 270.

- Fundraising Events/Special Initiatives Volunteers

Volunteers assist with the activities associated with the tasks planned by the organizing committees. This is generally a half-day commitment. Call x 270.
